Policy and Procedures # 12 – Range Privileges

This Policy and Procedure describes the criteria and responsibilities for issuing a Range Privilege Card to individuals who are no longer employed by the Rio Salado Sportsman's Club, Inc.

1. Individuals who are no longer employees of the Club may be issued a Range Privilege Card if they meet the following criteria.

- Served 3 years or more years as a Range Safety Officer or employee.
- Must not have left the Range's employ for cause.
- Must be 65 years old or older.

2. A Range Privilege Card will authorize the individual to use the facilities of the Usery Mountain Shooting Range for free, subject to the following conditions: A) The individual may only use the Main Range unless they are qualified for other ranges under the same conditions as members; B) The individual must pay the same fees as all other users (e.g. target fees, but exempting the daily Main Range fee); C) The individual must pay all match fees in which he or she participates; D) Range Privilege Cards may be revoked at the discretion of the Rio Salado Sportsmans' Club, Inc.; E) It is the individual's responsibility to apply for a Range Privilege Card and to provide proof of qualification.

3. The Range Privilege Card is **not** a membership card, and conveys no membership benefits such as voting, the right to attend meetings, or discounts. An individual wanting to become a member must purchase a membership under the same conditions as any other individual.

4. The Range Manager will issue the card and will maintain a computerized record of all former employees issued a Range Privilege Card. The Range Manager is authorized to certify the reverse of the card for those ranges on which the individual is qualified. The Range Manager will ensure any former employee requesting a Range Privilege Card reads this Policy and Procedure. Cards will be laminated for display, and may be reissued if lost or upon turn-in of the previous one.

5. A sample of a Range Privilege Card is below. It will be worn at all times when on the Range.
